### **Quick Guide Manual**





Key	Description
Power/End Key	Press and hold to turn Airplane mode on or off, restart, or to power off. Press to end or cancel a call. Press to return to the home screen
Left Soft Key/ Right Soft Key	Press to select the options at the left/right corner of the bottom of the display. The options change depending on the application/function in use.
Recent Apps Key	Press to see recently used applications
Volume Up/Down Key	Press or hold to turn the volume up or down
Camera Key	Press to launch the camera from the home or apps screen, or take a picture when the Camera app is already launched.
Send Key	Press to place or answer a call. Press to launch the Recent Calls app from the home screen to view recent calls.
Clear Key	Press to delete text or numbers before the cursor
4-Way Navigation Key	Press up/down/left/right to access designated functions from the home screen, navigate options on the display, or move the cursor
Center	Press to select a highlighted item on the screen or perform the function at the bottom center of the display
Vibration Mode Key	From the home screen, press and hold to activate/deactivate vibration mode. In a text-editing screen, press and hold to change input mode.

# **Charging the Battery**

1. Connect the adapter to the charging port. Ensure that the adapter is inserted with the correct orientation.

NOTE: Do not force the connector into the charging port.



- 2. Connect the charger to a standard AC wall outlet. If the phone is on, you'll see a charging icon, such as or, appear in the Status Bar.
- **3.** Disconnect the charger when the battery is fully charged.

# Turning The Phone On / Off

#### Turn Phone On

 Press and hold the Power/End Key to turn on your phone.

### **Turn Phone Off**

- Press and hold the Power/End Key to open the options menu.
- ♦ Select Power off> OK.

# Making & Answering Calls

### Placing a Call by Dialing

- **1. Press** the **Power/End** Key, then enter the phone number with the keypad. Press the **Clear** Key to delete incorrect digits.
  - 2. Press the Send Key to dial the number entered.

### Ending a Call

During a call, press the Power/End Key.

### Answering Calls

When you receive a phone call, press the **Send** key to answer the call.

You can also press the **Power/End** key to reject the call.

### **Ending Calls**

During a call, press the Power/End key.

# Getting to Know the Home Screen



## Call Features

Options available during a call.

Options available during a call.	
Speaker	Press the <b>Center Key</b> to turn the speakerphone on/off.
Mute	Press the <b>Right Soft Key</b> to mute or unmute the microphone.
Add A Call	Select <b>Options</b> > <b>Add call</b> to make another call separately from the first call, which is put on hold.
Merge Calls	Select <b>Options</b> > <b>Merge calls</b> to merge the separate calls into a single conference call.
Swap	Select <b>Options</b> > <b>Swap</b> to put the caller you are speaking to on hold, and switch to the other call that has been put on hold.

### **Contacts**

To see your contacts, from the home screen, select **Contacts**.

### **Checking Contact Details**

- 1. From the home screen, select **Contacts** (**Left Soft Key**) to access your contacts list.
- **2**. Scroll through the list to view all your contacts.
- Select a contact and then press the Center Key to view its details.

### Adding a New Contact

- 1. From the home screen, select Contacts (Left soft Key) > Select Options (Left Soft Key).
- Select New contact to add a new contact.
   NOTE: If you have no contacts added yet,
   select CREATE A NEW CONTACT.
- 3. Enter the contact's name, phone numbers, email addresses and other information. (To adjust input mode, hold down the # key)
- 4. To enter more information, select ADD ANOTHER FIELD at the bottom of the display and press the Center Key.
- 5. Select **Options** > **Done** to save the contact.

# Transferring Contacts

### Using Bluetooth or Messaging

You can also quickly share your contacts using Bluetooth or Messaging.

#### **Sharing Contacts**

- 1. From the home screen, select Contacts.
- 2. Select Options > Import/Export > Share visible contacts.
- **3**. Choose to share via Messaging or Bluetooth. Phone will export your contacts into a vCard file.
- **4**. Follow the prompts on the display to send the vCard file.

# Setting Up Voicemail Using \*86

- **1. Press \*86** and the **Send** key. Your phone will dial the voicemail number and you will hear voice prompt to guide you through the steps.
  - Press 1 for English, 2 for Spanish
  - Press # to confirm your language choice.
- 2. Enter a password & press #. You will need to enter this password every time you listen to your massages.
- 3. To select a greeting:
- Press 1 for the standard greeting listing your phone number.
  - Press 2 for the standard greeting listing your name.
  - Press 3 to record a personal greeting.
- **4.** Once you have selected your greeting, you will be given final reminders. Then **Press 2**. The voicemail system will ask you to choose:
  - Send a Message.
- Check Receipt (to assure the message was received).
  - · Personal Options.
  - · Disconnect.

**NOTE:** Using this method to set up your voicemail uses minutes from your plan.

### Messages

#### **Opening the Messaging Screen**

From the home screen, select **Messages (Right Soft Key)**. The Messaging screen opens, where you can create a new message or open an ongoing message thread.

- Select Options (Left Soft Key) > New message to write a new text or multimedia message.
- Select an **Existing message thread** to open the conversation.

#### Sending a Message

- 1. On the Messaging screen, select Messages (Right Soft Key) > Options (Left Soft Key) > New message.
- **2**. Add recipients in one of the following ways:
- Select the **To** field and manually enter the recipient's number or the contact name. If the phone presents a few suggestions, select the one you want to add.
- Select the To field and press the Center Key to select recipients from contacts, call history, or contact groups. NOTE: To remove a recipient, press the Clear Key.
- 3. Use the 4-Way Navigation Key to arrow down to the input text box at the bottom and type the content of your text message.
  4. If you want to send a multimedia
- message, select **Options (Left Soft Key)** > **Insert attach** to attach a photo or video to the message.
- 5. Press the **Center Key** to select **SEND** for your message to be sent.

**NOTE:** Do not add an attachment if you want to send a text message. Otherwise, you may be charged for a multimedia message.

### Replying to a Message

- 1. On the **Messaging screen**, select the thread that has the message you want to reply to.
- 2. Type your reply in the text box at the bottom. You can select **Options (Left Soft Key)** > Insert attach if you want to reply with an MMS. 3. Press the **Center Key** to send.

# **Capturing a Photo**



1. From the home screen, select Center Key > Camera.

**NOTE**: You can also press the **Camera Key** from the home or apps screen to launch the Camera app.

- **2**. Aim the camera at the subject and make any necessary adjustments.
- To use a filter effect, select **Options (Left Soft Key) > Filter > arrow down** to choose an option.
- To access White Balance, Brightness, and ISO, select Options (Left Soft Key) > White balance/Brightness/ISO. Press the Center Key, and then choose an option.
- To adjust camera settings such as picture size and video quality, select Options (Left Soft Key) > Settings then arrow down to choose an option.
- 3. Press the Center Key or the Camera Key to take a picture.

### Recording a Video

1. From the home screen, select **Center Key** > arrow to **Camera**.

**NOTE:** You can also press the **Camera Key** from the home or apps screen to launch the Camera app.

- 2. Press left on the 4-Way Navigation Key, to switch to the camcorder. The shutter button will turn red.
- 3. Aim the camera at the subject and make any necessary adjustments.

**NOTE:** You can press the **Volume Key** to zoom in or zoom out before and during recording.

- 4. Press the Center Key or the Camera Key to start recording. You can also press the Left Soft Key to pause and resume recording.
- 5. Press the **Center Key** or the **Camera Key** again to stop recording.

# Speed Dial

#### Setting Speed Dials

You can press and hold the **1-9 Keys** in the home screen to call the corresponding speed dial number. The number **1 Key** is reserved to speed dial your **Voicemail**.

#### To assign a speed dial key:

- 1. From the home screen, select Center Key > Settings > Call settings > Speed dial.
- 2. Select a speed dial entry and then press the Center Kev.
- **3**. Select a contact number from the contact list, and then press the **Center Key**.
